And, people always ask, "When are the Terrace Garage Sales?" May 17th.



Legislative News

+The budget has come in at the allowable 2% tax cap. Copies of the full budget are available at the town hall.

+Several new pieces of equipment will be purchased for the highway department including a second leaf vacuum. Funds available from the 2021 American Rescue Plan defrayed the expense.

+The need for updates for sewer and water was given a grant of \$6 million of the possible \$9 million expense from the 2021 federal infrastructure act through NYS.

We'd like to tell you a bit about our initial plans for the savings from printing and postage costs.

We're planning to significantly increase our charitable contributions within the Terrace.

First, we'll be increasing our Scholarship donation from \$500 for 2 graduating seniors to \$1000 for each of 3 of our seniors who are heading for higher education. We'll continue improvements in our parks, both Tioga Blvd and Woodside.

Our Santa and Halloween events will continue but we're planning several more family and adult events as well. There are several charitable contributions in the Terrace that we are looking to increase or add also.




