



Approved Meeting Minutes June 13th, 2017

Meeting Minutes (Joe Sienko, Secretary) – A motion to accept the May, 2017 meeting minutes, as presented, was made by Chuck and seconded by Rich.

Treasurer's Report (Sue Balliet, Treasurer) – Sue submitted the June 2017 budget. There was \$6,386.00 of income this month. This was all from the Membership Drive. The expenses this month were \$516.57 and are broken down as follows, \$268.40 for NDO insurance, \$194.52 for printing materials and pens for the Membership Drive and \$53.65 for pens for our Newcomers. A motion to accept this month's budget report, as presented, was made by Linda F. and seconded by Jennifer S.

Garage Sale (Rich Ward, Chairperson) – Rich reports that he did have a few people contact him about their streets not getting no parking signs. There were some signs pulled on routes and people parking there regardless of the signs. Boy Scouts had set up in the street and were selling hot dogs creating a potential problem of being hit by a car. Highway/Legislature (Meredith Bocek, Chairperson) – Meredith gave us information about the next town board meeting. Scholarship (Chuck Place, Chairperson) – Chuck reports that the winner this year of our Scholarship was Shelly Vickler. She will be given the \$500.00 once she submits the information to Sue or Chuck on which college she plans to attend.

Socials (Jeanet Hazar, Chairperson) – NO REPORT. Jennifer S. reports that her friend could instruct the self defense course that Jeanet had mentioned having as an event.

Website (Mike Showalter, Website Administrator) – Mike reports he's seen a spike in the use of the website in May. He has fielded many questions about the grass not being cut at a house on Highland.

Old Business: Nancy had reported that she got no response from the letter she sent about two properties of concern in the Terrace. At that point our guest Mike McCann stated he was the owner of the house on Frederick that has been under repair for many years. He said that he is trying to get it fixed up. He has had some medical issues and has had trouble getting it done. He estimates the house should be livable again in 2-3yrs.

New Business: Jim reports that he will be retiring from his position as Vice President at the end of this year. We will need to put information about needing someone to take on that role in our next Newsletter and on our Website.
