TTCA 2022 Scholarships For High School Seniors

For the last twenty--three years, the Tioga Terrace Civic Association has awarded a scholarship to a college-bound senior who has demonstrated regular service to his or her school community. This year the Civic Association will be awarding two \$500 scholarships to two worthy students. To be eligible, the students must be a graduating senior, a resident of Tioga Terrace and accepted into a continuing education program.

Typically, the scholarship application period is announced in February-March by the Vestal High School Guidance Department, which also provides the application forms (watch for announcements and/ or postings). Please note that the selection criteria are identical to that of the Apalachin Lions Club's annual scholarships. If you apply for the Lion's Club scholarship, and live in the Terrace, your application will automatically be considered for the TTCA scholarship.

The Civic Association is pleased to offer these scholarships as a way to encourage, recognize and reward civic responsibility among young adults in the Terrace. If you have been active in service to your school and community, we encourage you to apply.
